# **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO APPLICANT**

## **CHAPTER 150 Of The Township Code:**

1. Those sales which are conducted at a private residence, commonly referred to as a "garage sale," "lawn sale," "attic sale" or "rummage sale," or any similar casual sale of tangible personal property, but limited to items of personal property owned by the residents of the private residence from which the sale is to be conducted.
2. Only two such licenses shall be issued to any one person or dwelling place within a twelve-month (12) period and no such license shall be issued for more than four (4) consecutive calendar days. Sales on successive weekends or with intervening non-sale days are considered separate sales.
3. All garage sales shall be conducted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. only.
4. Garage Sales are permitted only as incidental to the residential use of a property and not intended to permit business in a residential zone.

## **SECTION 171-17 Of The Township Code:**

1. No person shall post or affix any notice, poster or other paper or device, calculated to attract the attention of the public, to any lamppost, public utility pole or shade tree or upon any public structure or building, except as may be authorized by the owners thereof, or required by law. A fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or imprisonment in the County Jail for a term in excess of ninety days or both. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.

## **ENFORCEMENT:**

### **SECTION 171-21 Of The Township Code:**

1. The Hanover Township Public Works, Building and Grounds and Park Maintenance Department, the Township of Hanover Police Department or the Property Maintenance Officer shall have the authority to enforce the terms and conditions of Chapter 171.

## **ALLOWABLE SIGNAGE:**

Sandwich board signage measuring not more than 18"x18" may be staked in the ground for notification purposes. All signs must be removed promptly following the garage sale.
