

ORDINANCE NO. 4-2010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING IMPROVEMENTS AT THE BEE MEADOW SWIMMING POOL FACILITY: (1) THE WET SANDBLASTING OF THE SWIMMING POOL FLOOR AND WALLS TO REMOVE THE EXISTING RUBBER BASE PAINT; (2) THE PAINTING OF THE SWIMMING FLOOR AND WALLS; AND (3) THE INSTALLATION OF A DRY CHEMICAL SUPPRESSION SYSTEM TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION FOR THE BEE MEADOW SWIMMING POOL MAINTENANCE SHOP AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$32,000.00 FROM THE SWIMMING ENTERPRISE FUND – CAPITAL ACCOUNT FOR 2010 AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR THE FINANCING OF THE PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the continual maintenance and improvement to the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool infrastructure is essential in order to maintain its integrity and reliability as a fully functional and operational amenity for the benefit of pool members; and

WHEREAS, to keep the pool in good condition, the Superintendent of the Parks and Recreation Department has recommended that the Township remove the existing rubber base paint by performing: (a) a wet sandblasting of the approximately 10,000 square foot size swimming pool floor; (b) the wet sandblasting of the approximately 2,500 square feet of pool walls; and (c) the painting of the pool floor and walls following the sandblasting. In addition, the Whippany Fire Department has recommended that the Township install a dry chemical suppression system to provide fire protection for the maintenance shop at the Bee Meadow Pool; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the recommendations of the Superintendent of the Parks and Recreation Department and with the concurrence of the Board of Recreation Commissioners, it is the intention of the governing body to authorize the needed maintenance work and further appropriate funds from the Swimming Pool Enterprise Funds' 2010 Capital Account and all prior years for the financing of the projects described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The following improvement repairs to the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool and the Pool maintenance shop are hereby authorized:

- A. The wet sandblasting of the swimming pool floor, approximately 10,000 square feet in size, in order to remove the rubber base paint;
- B. The wet sandblasting of the swimming pool walls, approximately 2,500 square feet in size, in order to remove the rubber base paint;
- C. The purchase of paint needed to repaint the floor and walls following the removal of the rubber base paint. The repainting shall be performed by employees of the Parks and Recreation Department;
- D. The purchase and installation of a dry chemical suppression system to provide fire protection for the maintenance shop located at the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool facility.

Section 2. In accordance with requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, the Superintendent of the Parks and Recreation Department is authorized and directed to obtain written quotations from vendors for the performance of the sandblasting work, and the purchase and installation of the dry chemical suppression system. The Superintendent is also authorized to purchase the paint either through the quotation process or the availability of paint pursuant to a valid New Jersey State Contract or contract awarded by the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council.

Section 3. For the performance of the repair work described in Section 1. of this Ordinance, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$32,000.00 from the Township's Swimming Pool Enterprise Fund – Capital Account for 2010 and all prior years.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
