## Summer Tour Program Information

**Description:** The Summer Tour program is a four-week program of scheduled trips offered to Hanover Township residents entering grades 7, 8, and 9 in September 2009. Participants are able to attend a variety of trips on a week-to-week basis, Monday through Thursday. All trips will be supervised by experienced program directors.

**Location:** All trips (excluding the pool) will meet at the Community Center located at 15 North Jefferson Road. Transportation will be provided to and from the Community Center. Campers must be dropped off and picked up at this location for all designated times. The only exception is the trip to the Bee Meadow Pool. Drop-off and pick-up at the Bee Meadow Pool is on the following Mondays: July 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, and 27<sup>th</sup>. The program directors will meet outside of the pool for sign-in and sign-out on these dates.

**Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures:** Participants must be signed in and signed out of the program each day that he or she attends. This signature must be that of an individual whose name is on **Form 2: Drop-off and Release Authorization**. If none of the authorized individuals are able to sign in/sign out the child, please provide a written note to the camper's program director. **No camper is allowed to walk or ride his or her bike to this program.**

**Pool Trip:** On Mondays, campers will attend a trip to the Bee Meadow Pool. Campers must be dropped off and picked up directly at the pool. If they wish to stay there after 2 p.m., campers must be signed out of the Summer Tour program. Only pool members who are 13 years old will be able to re-enter the pool.

**Cost:** The cost of the Summer Tour program is \$110.00 per week. This cost includes all trip fees and transportation. Please refer to the enclosed trip calendar and trip information sheets for any additional fees (such as food).

**Hours:** As program hours vary from each day, please be aware of all drop-off and pick-up times. Please also note that late pickups are a major imposition on the program staff. Therefore, there is a \$1.00 late fee assessed for every minute late. This fee should be paid directly to the program directors at time of pick-up.

**Trips:** Please be aware of the calendar and trip information sheets regarding the different drop-off and pick-up times and locations, clothing requirements, and food services. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY TRIPS PARTICIPANTS CANNOT ATTEND. Due to the high cost of transportation for Tuesday trips, a minimum of 15 participants is necessary. If not met, trips will be canceled and trip cost will be reimbursed.** In the event of inclement weather, call the Recreation Activity Line at 973-887-7870 by 9 a.m. If a trip is canceled due to the weather, participants have the option of meeting at the Community Center from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., where they will have access to the game room and a pizza lunch.

**Registration:** Registration for the Summer Plus Program will occur at the Community Center on the following three dates: April 25<sup>th</sup>, May 1<sup>st</sup> and May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please keep the calendar and trip information for personal records. In order to complete registration, please bring payment (cash or check made out to Township of Hanover) and the following completed forms, **Form 1: Camper Registration (double-sided)** and **Form 2: Drop-off and Release Authorization**. At time of registration, each participant will receive two program T-shirts that must be worn on all trips.
