

Malapardis Road from Mountview Road to Ridgedale Avenue

Public Service Electric and Gas (PSE&G) has scheduled pavement restoration on the referenced street. PSE&G is required to resurface half of the roadway where the gas main installation occurred (i.e. odd numbered houses along Malapardis Road).

Milling will be performed on August 10, 2017.

Paving will be performed on August 11, 2017.

All work is subject to change and WEATHER PERMITTING.

MILLING ADVISORY

Parking will be prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during milling operations but the street will be open to local traffic only. There will, however, be considerable construction vehicle traffic and a rough road surface so please drive carefully through the area. After milling and prior to paving, please be mindful of raised manhole and inlet castings and use care entering and leaving your driveway and side streets due to the increased lip along the curbline.

PAVING ADVISORY

Parking will be prohibited from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during paving operations scheduled for August 11, 2017, and the southerly half of the street will be closed to all traffic at various times of the day as the paving operation proceeds down the roadway. Driveways that connect to the southerly half of the road within the paving limits will have limited access to Malapardis Road. There will also be limited access for those streets whose only access is from the southerly half of Malapardis Road, namely Mountview Road, Oakview Road, Parkside Drive and Quinlisk Road. All cars must be removed from these driveways and side streets that connect to the southerly half of Malapardis Road by 7:00 a.m. to avoid being prevented from exiting onto Malapardis Road.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING PICKUP

Garbage and recycling pick-up will not be affected.
