

ORDINANCE NO. 53-2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 267-43. SCHEDULE XIII: PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES UNDER CHAPTER 267 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC WITH THE INCLUSION OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON MELANIE LANE

WHEREAS, a need exists to prohibit the parking of all vehicles on the north side of Melanie Lane from its intersection with Algonquin Parkway to the border with East Hanover Township; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the parking of vehicles is needed on Melanie Lane, the Township will permit parking on the south side of Melanie Lane from its intersection with Algonquin Parkway to the border with East Hanover Township.

NOW, THEREOFRE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with provisions of Section 267-17. entitled "Parking Prohibited at all Times.." under Chapter 267 of the Code of the Township entitled Vehicles and Traffic, Section 267-43. Schedule XIII: Parking Prohibited at all Times. Is hereby amended and supplemented with the inclusion of the following:

"For the purposes of this Ordinance, Melanie Lane, in the Whippany Section of the Township shall be considered to extend in an east-west direction.

Melanie Lane. No person shall park a vehicle at any time on the north side of Melanie Lane from its intersection with Algonquin Parkway to the border with East Hanover Township."

Section 2. Upon final passage and publication, the Public Works Department, in coordination with the Township Engineer, shall erect and maintain the necessary regulatory signs prohibiting parking at all times on the north side of Melanie Lane as set forth herein pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198, and in conformance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices.

Section 3. All ordinances of the Township of Hanover which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.



Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
