

ORDINANCE NO. 20-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW ALTERNATOR ASSEMBLY FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S 100kW NATURAL GAS EMERGENCY GENERATOR BY GENSERVE PURSUANT TO MORRIS COOPERATIVE PRICING COUNCIL CONTRACT NO. 46 AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$50,000.00 FROM THE UNALLOCATED PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP'S 2020 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR THE FINANCING OF THE REPAIR

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Township upgraded the 100kW natural gas emergency generator which supplies Police Headquarters with sufficient power during a prolonged power outage; and

WHEREAS, the emergency generator is located on the roof of Police Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, the alternator and coil which generates electricity has failed and requires the installation of a new alternator assembly within the generator; and

WHEREAS, a standby temporary generator has been acquired in order to provide power to Police Headquarters in the event of a power outage; and

WHEREAS, in order to install the new alternator assembly, a crane will be needed to remove the old parts and install the new alternator equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The governing body hereby authorizes the removal of the failed alternator assembly, the replacement and installation of a new generator alternator assembly, coil and all related parts, materials and labor associated with the Police Department's 100kW natural gas emergency generator. This authorization includes payment for the temporary emergency generator and the rental of a crane.

Section 2. The removal, replacement and installation of the alternator assembly and coil will be performed by **GenServe** under Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council Contract No. 46 awarded by the Randolph Township Municipal Council.


Section 3. For the financing of all work related to the removal and replacement of the alternator assembly, coil and all related parts, materials and labor, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$50,000.00 from the unallocated portion of the Township's 2020 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.


