

COVID-19 VACCINATION SCHEDULING SUPPORT LINE FOR AGES 75 AND OLDER



The New Jersey Department of Health is providing vaccination scheduling support for seniors ages 75 and older.

Individuals 75 and older, who are registered on the New Jersey Vaccination Scheduling System (NJVSS) *will receive a call* from the state to schedule a vaccination appointment at a NJVSS location (e.g Walmart, Shop-Rite).

The New Jersey Vaccination Support line **(856-249-7007)** can be used for the following:

- Rescheduling of dedicated appointments
- Registration and addition to the 75+ NJVSS waiting list
