

ORDINANCE NO. 31-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION §198-21. ENTITLED "REGISTRATION REQUIRED" UNDER ARTICLE IV, CHAPTER 198 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED BEE MEADOW POND BOATING REGULATIONS BY ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION PERIOD

WHEREAS, the Township Committee adopted Ordinance No. 11-2018 on May 24, 2018 which established a new Article IV under Chapter 198 of the Code of the Township entitled Bee Meadow Pond Boating Regulations; and

WHEREAS, §198-21. entitled "Registration Required" needs to be amended to include the annual time frame in which a boating vessel registration fee is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. §198-21. entitled "Registration Required" under Article IV, Chapter 198 of the Code of the Township entitled Bee Meadow Pond Boating Regulations is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

"Any person wishing to use and operate a boating vessel described in §198-19. above, is required to register the vessel on an annual basis from January 1 through December 31 of every calendar year. Boating vessels must be registered with the Township's Recreation and Park Administration Department and pay an annual fee for each vessel as follows:

- A. Resident Fee for Each Vessel.....\$25.00 per annum;
- B. Non-Resident Fee for Each Vessel.....\$50.00 per annum; and
- C. Volunteer Cedar Knolls & Whippany
Firefighters and EMT's.....Exempt/Annual Fee
Is Waived

Registration fees shall not be prorated at any time during a calendar year. All fees are made payable to the Township of Hanover.

Section 2. In case, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.
