

**ORDINANCE NO. 33-2022**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AUTHORIZING VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWNSHIP'S MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AND ROADWAY DRAINAGE SYSTEM AND APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF \$409,600.00.00 FOR SAID IMPROVEMENTS FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S 2022 IMPROVEMENTS TO BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS AND INSTALLATION OF STORM DRAINAGE OTHER EXPENSE ACCOUNTS INTO THE 2022 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR THE FINANCING OF THE PROJECTS DESCRIBED HEREIN**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee appropriated funds in the Improvements to Buildings and Grounds and Installation of Storm Drainage Other Expense Accounts in the 2022 Current Fund Budget for the following municipal facility and roadway storm water drainage improvement projects:

1. Replacement of the Existing Air Conditioning System in the Communications Room in the Municipal Building;
2. Replacement of the Existing Air Conditioning System in the Township's Multi-Purpose Community Center; and
3. Installation of a New Storm Water Drainage System on Horse Hill Road in the Vicinity of Saddle Road; and

**WHEREAS**, funds for these projects were appropriated in the 2022 Current Fund Budget, Account Numbers 0052 and 0046; and

**WHEREAS**, because of time constraints and attention to other priority capital infrastructure projects, the Engineering Department was unable to complete the three projects described above; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer has recommended that the funds allocated and approved in the Improvements to Buildings and Grounds and Installation of Storm Drainage Other Expense Accounts in the 2022 Current Fund Budget be encumbered and transferred into the Township's 2022 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years so that the improvement projects can be completed in the near future.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The following municipal facility and roadway storm water drainage improvement projects are hereby re-authorized and funds from their individual 2022 Current Fund Budget Other Expense Line Items are transferred and

encumbered into the 2022 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years as described below:

1. Replacement of the Existing Air Conditioning System in the Communications Room in the Municipal Building:  
From Account No. 0052, Line Item Nos. 132-0052-855 and 132-0052-946 to Account No.: 410-5643 855..... \$24,000.00
  
2. Replacement of the Existing Air Conditioning System in the Township's Multi-Purpose Community Center:  
From Account No. 0052, Line Item No. 132-0052-940 to Account No.: 410-5643-940..... \$185,600.00
  
3. Installation of a New Storm Water Drainage System on Horse Hill Road in the vicinity of Saddle Road:  
From Account No. 0046, Line Item No. 132-0046-326 to Account No.: 410-5643-326..... \$200,000.00
  
- Total Authorized Appropriation..... \$409,600.00

Section 2. The Township Engineer and/or Assistant Township Engineer are authorized and directed to retain the services of licensed professional engineers and/or land surveyors in order to prepare the necessary drawings, plans and specifications for the replacement and upgrade of the Communications Room Air Conditioning System, the Multi-Purpose Community Center Air Conditioning System and construction of the Horse Hill Road Drainage System.

Section 3. In accordance with the drawings, plans and specifications prepared by the licensed professional engineers and/or land surveyors, the Township Engineer and/or Assistant Township Engineer are authorized and directed, based on the estimated project costs to be expended, to obtain written competitive quotations and/or sealed competitive bids for the improvements described in Section 1 above, all in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et seq.

Section 4. In case, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
